## 2017-2018 School Budget Highlights

- Reduced Out Of District Placement from 5 to 2 students
- Full series Science books for grades K to 5
- 1:1 Chromebooks for the Grades 5
- Laptops for teachers at both Stevenson and Churchill
- Adding one part-time staff to ESL Program
- Adding one shared Clerk position Superintendent and Business offices
- Installation of the third and final phase of Accounting/Payroll/Personnel software package
- Installation of Sonic Firewall District wide
- Phasing out transportation agreement with Sussex County Regional Transportation Cooperative and contracting with Essex Regional Educational Services Commission
- Negotiated Health Benefits contract with current provider to mirror State Health Benefits Plan Aetna Direct 10 option
- Review and analyze the 2016 District Demographic Study and develop plans to address changes in enrollment and the impact on educational programs
