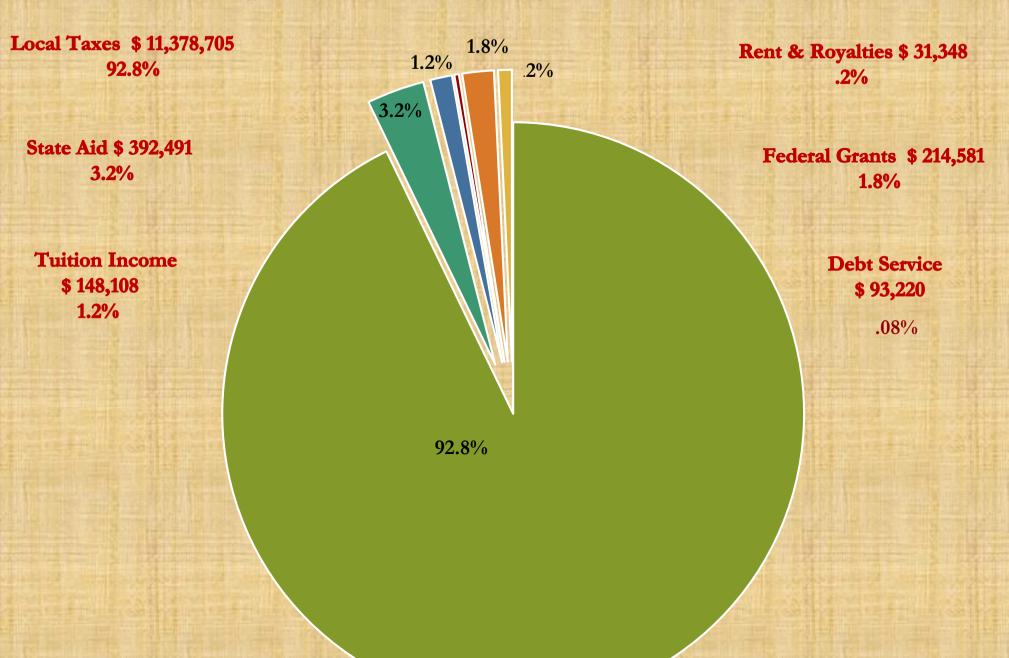

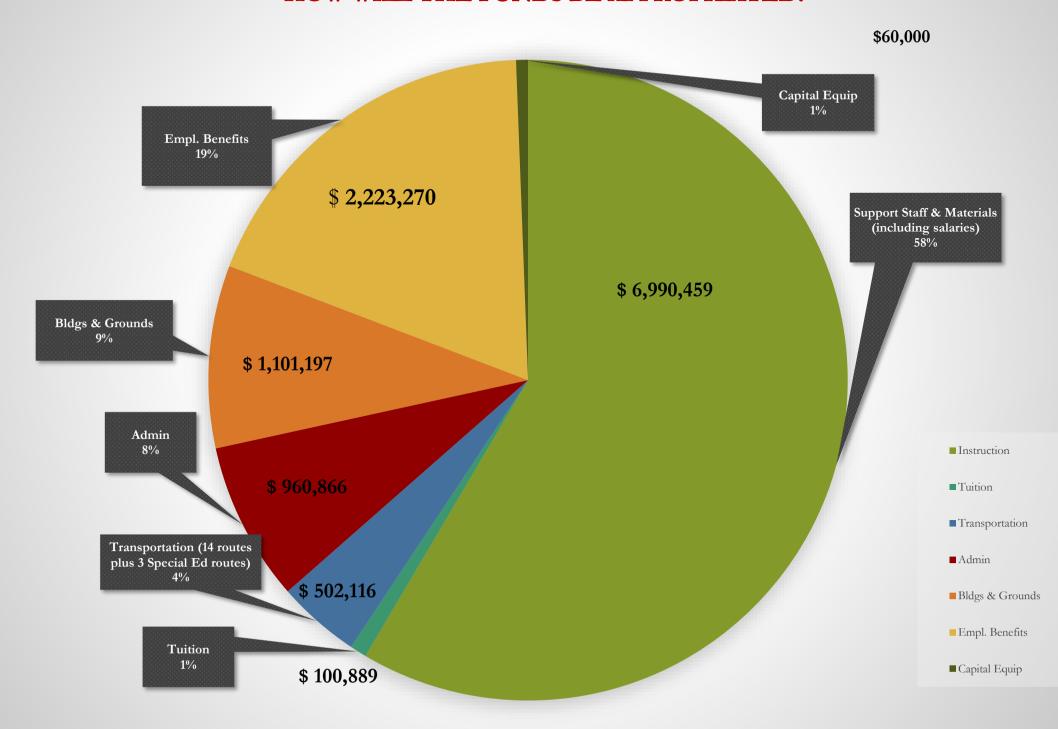

Ratable increase

7,141,500 means an \$11.00 increase (per year) included in final school tax

That means of the 2.49% increase, 0.49% is due to increase ratables.

So, the NET TAX LEVY increase is really 2.0% and the 0.49% equals = \$54,098

The total \$ increase of \$53.79 is comprised of: \$11 increase of ratable and \$43 new tax increase.

Ratable Increase: (\$7,141,500)

This increase contributed \$11 to the \$54

Without the increase, the levy would have gone up only 2.%, or \$43 on the average home.
